

WALT design and make a stained glass window.

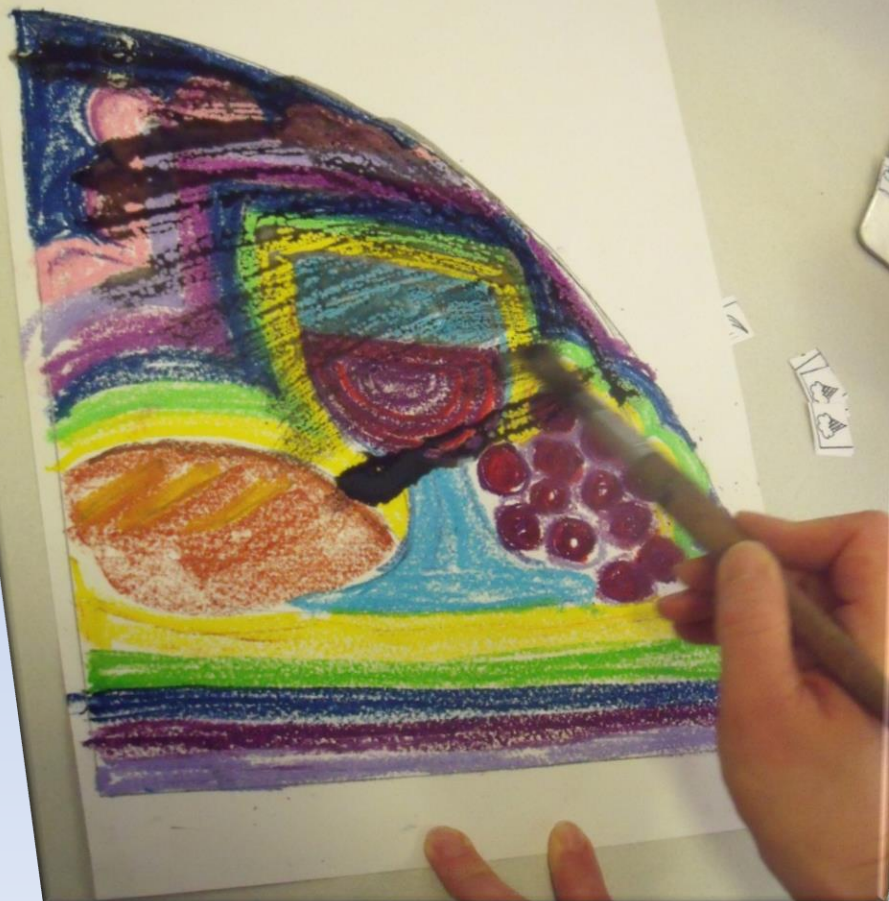


Draw your design in pencil.

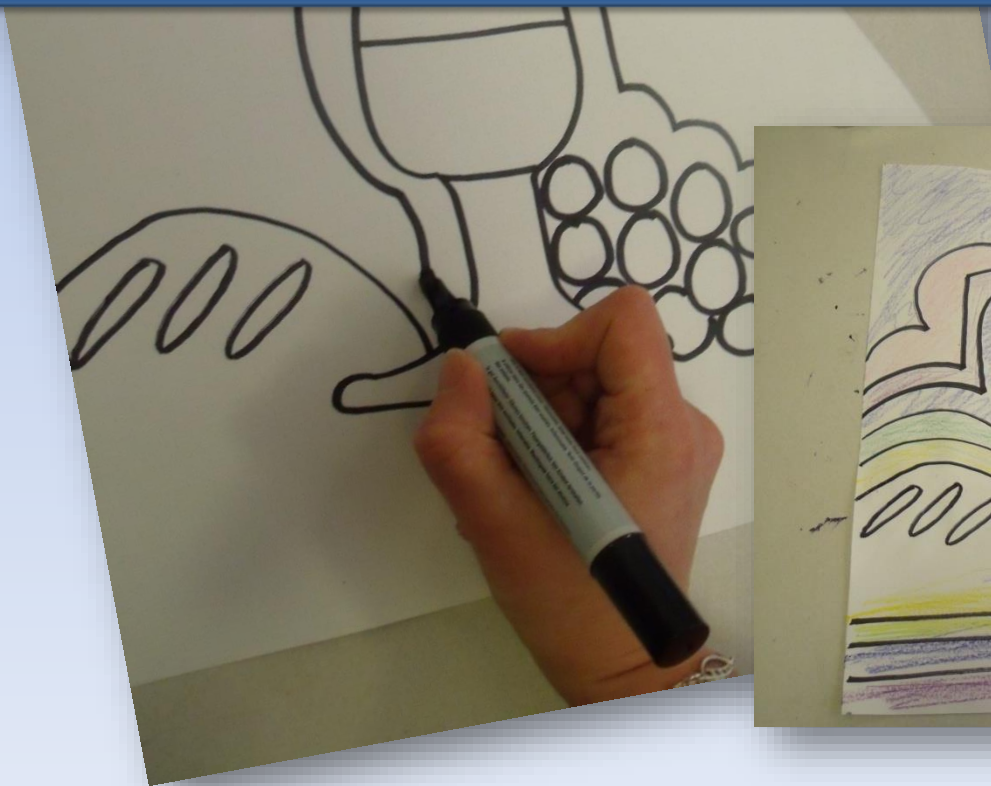
Colour your design using blocks of colour made with oil pastels.



Cover your design with a black wash.



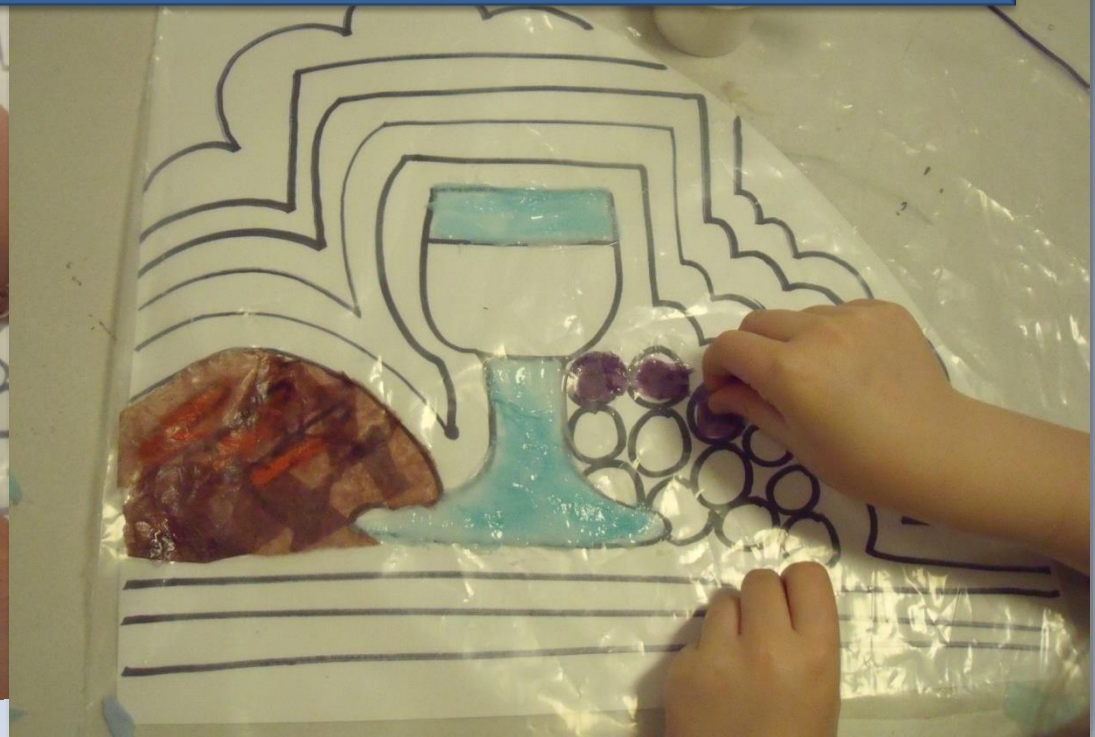
Draw your final design onto the large, paper 'quarter circle', using pencil, and then go over with a marker pen. Colour your design with crayon.



Cover your design with the plastic sheet, laying it flat. Bluetack it into place to stop it moving.



Paste glue onto the plastic sheet and lay 'tissue paper' over the top. Carefully follow the outline and colour of the design.



As you work, spread glue over the top of the tissue paper to make it lay flat.



You can make the colours darker by building up the layers of tissue and make different colours by laying one colour of tissue paper on top of another.





Carefully cover all the plastic sheet until your stained glass window is complete.



On top of the dried tissue paper draw the original outlines between the different colours, using a black marker pen



Trim the panel and see what it looks like against the window.
