


Book	Tyrannosaurus drip

English	<p>Look at the pictures and discuss what you see.</p> <p>Describe what happens on each page</p> <p>Listen/sing along to the song by Julia Donaldson https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=y7N_yYktD48</p> <p>Find about and write about a dinosaur.</p> <p>Act out the story as it is read to you.</p> <p>Discuss and write down what are the difference between the Duckbilled dinosaurs, Tyrannosaurus Rex and the Compsognathus.</p> <p>Lots of Dinosaur names are shortened in the book because they are so long. Can you think of other words that are shortened?</p> <p>What words can you make out of the letters d i n o s a u r.</p>
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Phonics	<p>Find words beginning with 'Dd' 'Tt' or any other letters. Then find words in the book that begin with those letters. Can you read them?</p> <p>Can you find every letter in the alphabet in the book?</p> <p>Use musical instruments or your voice to make the duckbill's hooting sound.</p> <p>Find the rhyming words in the story, then write them down.</p>
Maths	<p>Research the size of dinosaurs, which is the tallest/shortest, heaviest/lightest, fastest/slowest</p> <p>Sort toy dinosaurs into small, medium and large</p> <p>How many Duckbilled dinosaurs are there on the last page?</p>
ICT	<p>Record yourself retelling parts of the story.</p> <p>Research dinosaurs online. Do you have a favourite?</p>
PSHE	<p>Fill a bowl with water and do some water play- if you have toy dinosaurs play with them in the water.</p> <p>Do a treasure hunt using toy dinosaurs or dinosaur eggs.</p>
Food tech	<p>Make cookies in the shape of dinosaurs using a mould or cutter</p>

<p>Science</p>	<p>Tyrannosaurs Drip was a herbivore. What does this mean? What other dinosaurs were herbivores?</p> <p>Tyrannosaurs Rex was a carnivore. What does this mean? What other dinosaurs were carnivores?</p> <p>Dinosaurs are extinct. Find out what extinct means? What other animals are extinct?</p> <p>How are dinosaurs adapted to their environment? Why would they have long necks? Sharp teeth?</p>
<p>Art</p>	<p>Make a dinosaur skeleton out of pasta</p> <p>Colour in a dinosaur</p> <p>Draw or paint the main characters from the story</p> <p>Make dinosaur eggs out of play-dough</p> <p>Make a model dinosaur</p>
