Phonics

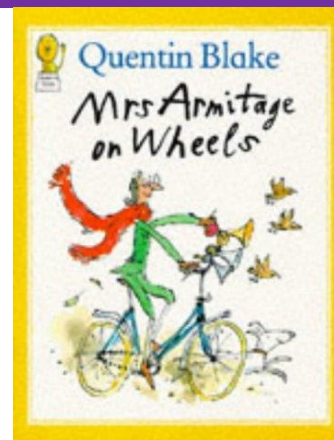
- Make different horn sounds
