


Book	Dinosaurs and all that rubbish

English	<p>Look at the pictures and discuss what you see.</p> <p>Retell the story with as much detail as you can remember.</p> <p>Act out all or part of the story. Use accents, sound effects and expression.</p> <p>Write a book review for book.</p> <p>Imagine a world that is full of rubbish and pollution. Can you think of words / phrases to describe it?</p> <p>What would the dinosaurs have said when they woke up?</p> <p>Can you describe a world that would be your paradise?</p> <p>Look at the pages in the book or video, describe the Earth in each picture.</p>	
Phonics	<p>Find words beginning with 'Aa' 'Hh' 'Cc' or any other letters. Then find words in the book that begin with those letters. Can you read them?</p> <p>Can you find every letter in the alphabet in the book?</p>	
Maths	<p>Count the number of insects / dinosaurs that you can see in the illustrations throughout the book.</p>	

ICT	<p>Record yourself retelling parts of the story.</p> <p>Find pictures of pollution on Earth, how did it happen? How can we fix it?</p> <p>Watch the mini animation of the book - <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=IrBQLezqPRk">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=IrBQLezqPRk</a></p>
PSHE	<p>Can you tidy up something in your house or garden like the dinosaurs?</p> <p>Why does the man want to go to the star? What does he think will be there that will make him happy?</p> <p>At the start of the story, the man dreams about the star. What are your hopes and dreams?</p> <p>The dinosaur says that the man should have been ruled by his heart and not his head. What does this mean?</p> <p>The dinosaur says the 'It's all yours but it is also all mine'. Does that mean we can do anything with we want with the planet?</p>
Food tech	<p>Find out what astronauts eat. What would make good space food?</p>
Science	<p>Did the man land on a star? How do you know?</p> <p>Lots of plants and trees grow throughout the story. Find out what plants need to grow healthily.</p> <p>Can you write some instructions to teach someone how to care for a plant?</p> <p>Research the topic of dinosaurs. What different types if dinosaurs were there? How were they similar / different?</p> <p>What can we recycle? Sort different materials into recycling, green waste and general rubbish.</p> <p>Pros and cons - should we use plastic? Can you find 3 reasons why we should use plastic (pros) and 3 reasons why we should not use plastic (cons)?</p> <p>What is a trash island?</p>

Art	<p>Design a model rocket to help the man reach the star.</p> <p>Look at the use of colour in the illustrations. Which pages are dark and gloomy? Which pages are bright and colourful? Could you try to recreate some of the pictures?</p> <p>Could you draw the same scene using dark colours and then using bright colours?</p> <p>Use the line drawings to colour dinosaur pictures</p>
Humanities	<p>Make a timeline showing when dinosaurs and humans have been alive.</p> <p>Find out about different types of pollution and how they affect the environment.</p> <p>Make a list of things that people can do to help the environment.</p> <p>Make a poster to persuade people to reduce waste, reuse items and recycle materials.</p> <p>Find out what happens to waste that isn't recycled.</p> <p>The dinosaur explains that the earth belongs to everyone. Could you use this message on a poster / banner?</p>
