
Spiders in Jelly Edible Sensory Recipe

Ingredients

Packets of jelly — you may want to mix colours or stick to just one Plastic spiders

A large tub
Edible glitter (optional)



Method

- 1. Make up the jelly, as per the instructions on the packet.
- 2. Drop the spiders into the liquid jelly, then add a layer of edible glitter on the top (optional).
- 4. The following day, tip the jelly into a large container, ready for the children to explore.
- 5. Anything can be added to the jelly; snakes, eyeballs, frogs etc. to fit in with any theme.
- 6. Do the children like the feel of the jelly? Can they find the objects?
