$$\text{Grapes} + \text{Orange} + \text{Orange} = 10$$

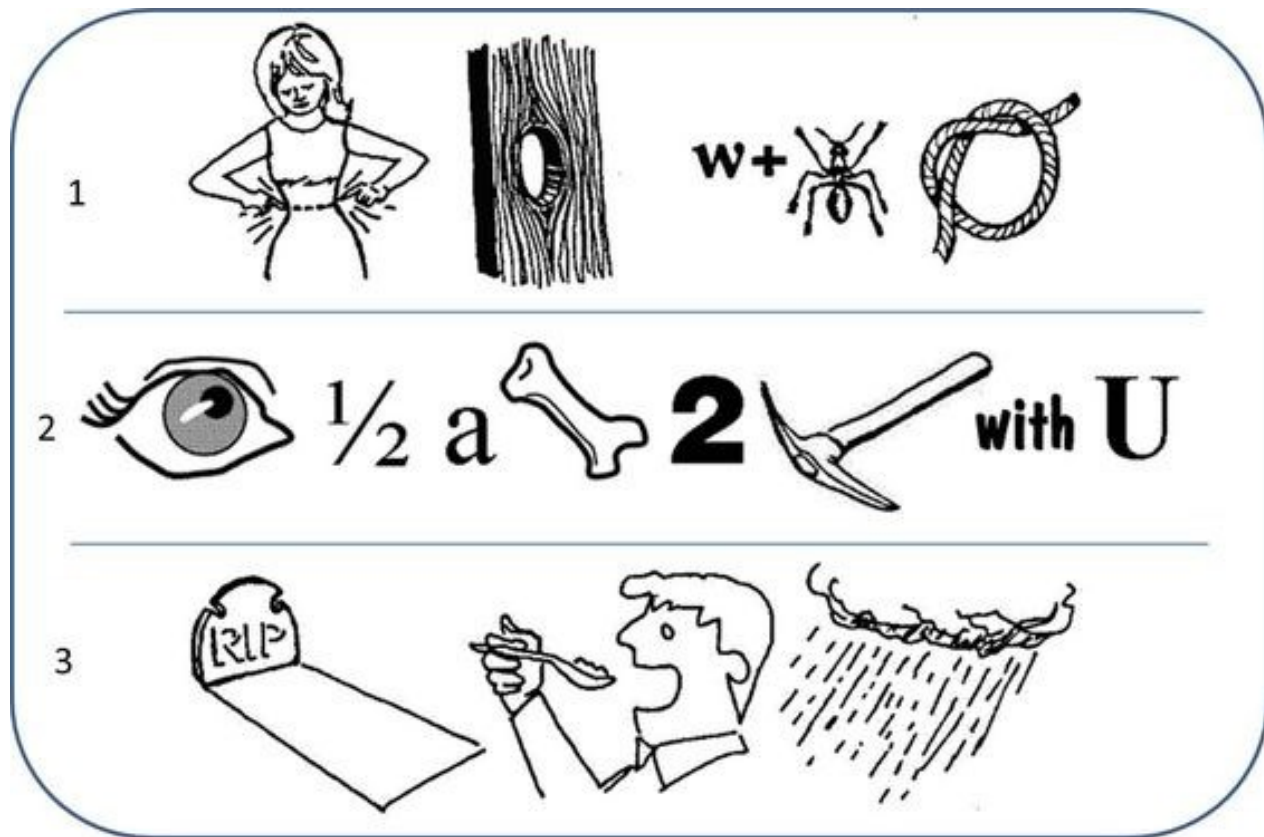
$$\text{Apple} + \text{Orange} - \text{Grapes} = ?$$

I tried blurring my eyes to stop myself reading the words rather than saying the colour but my times were still rubbish.

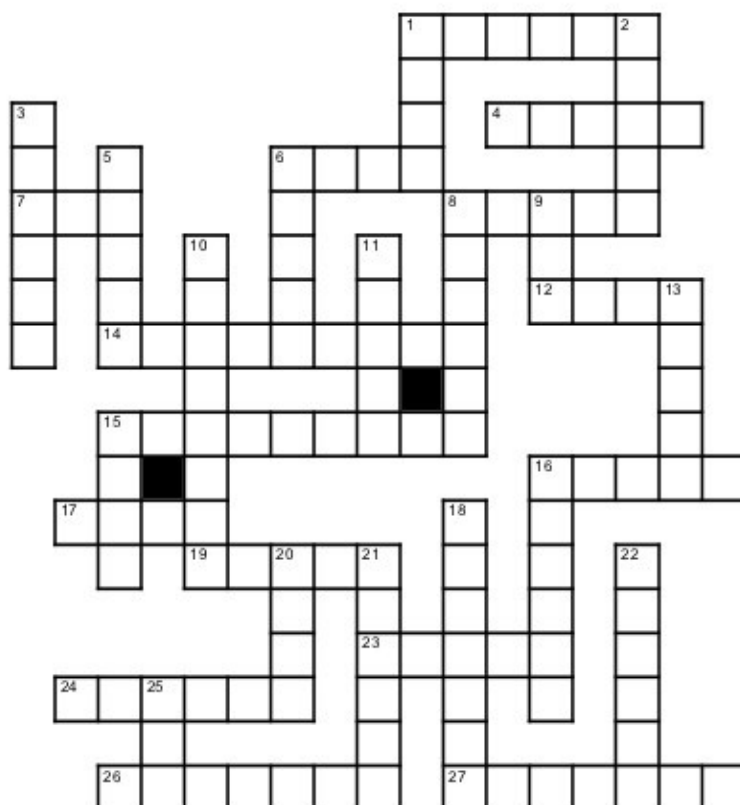

Can you use the clues to work out who chose which shape?



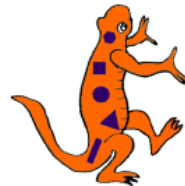






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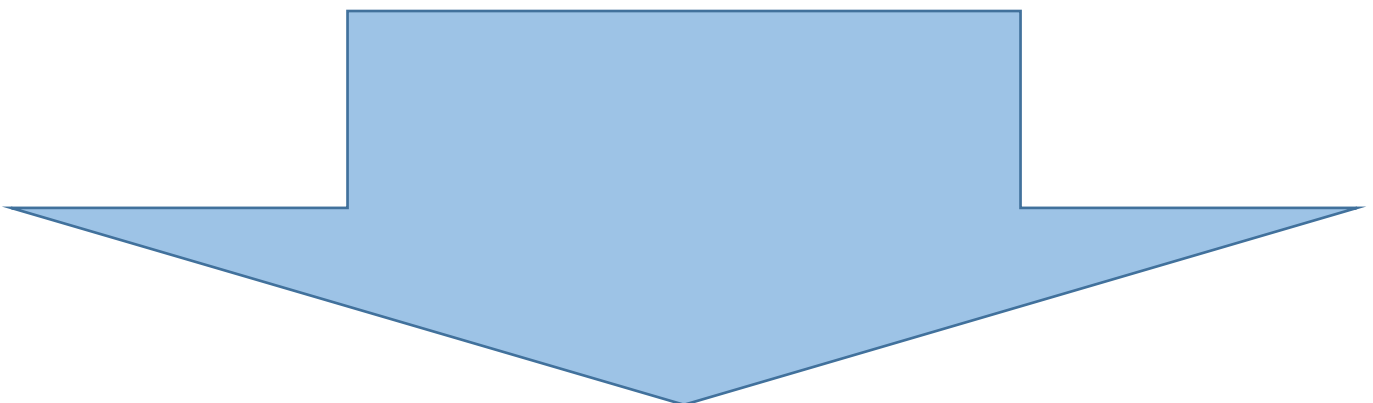


NEW LOOK FE DEPARTMENT!
